

105 Interpretation.

- (1) **In General.** The provisions of this Code shall be interpreted as the minimum requirements necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Code. Except as herein provided, the provisions of this Code are cumulative and in addition to the provisions of other laws and ordinances governing the same subjects. Where the provisions of this Code impose greater restrictions than those of any law, other ordinance or regulation, the provisions of this Code shall be controlling. Where the provisions of any law, other ordinance or regulation impose greater restrictions than this Code, such greater restrictions shall be controlling. Interpretations of the provisions of this Code shall be provided as necessary by the Council. In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this Code shall be held to be minimum requirements and shall be liberally construed in favor of the City of the Village of Minnetonka Beach and shall not be deemed a limitation or repeal of any other powers granted by State Statutes.
- (2) **Headings.** Chapter, Section and Subsection headings throughout this Code are for convenience only and shall have no legal effect.
