We are going to need a little extra help this spring and summer keeping our prized parks, trails, and swim beach safe, clean and beautiful for all to enjoy.

Minnetonka Beach is fortunate to have four parks, a swim beach, a lovely promenade, and trails. These valued community assets need to be attended to in order to keep them in shape.

While much of the upkeep of these properties is undertaken by our Public Works Superintendent and outside vendors, they all need some extra tender loving care from May 1st through September 30th.

To that end, we are reaching out to individuals, families, neighborhoods, and other coalitions of the willing to help out by

Adopting a Park.

The properties include:

City Hall Park, Half Moon Park, Pay Peters Park and Lafayette Park, each of which require a sponsor for light grooming twice monthly and a monthly check of playground equipment.

Swim Beach, light cleaning, raking, grooming, and watering the flowers between vendor service.

Dakota Trail, pulling garlic mustard plants along the trail for one weekend morning in May/June.

Promenade, the tree-lined landscape between Northview Road and Westwood Road in front of City Hall, water the library window box.

We ask that all who adopt a park come with work gloves, boots and/or other gear appropriate for the weather and the task.

For those who adopt a park we will give out our newly designed baseball caps and shirts.
