

**CITY OF THE VILLAGE OF MINNETONKA BEACH
NOTICE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of the Village of Minnetonka Beach, Hennepin County, MN will meet on Monday, April 13, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. to consider the following amendment to the City Code Section 202 Subdivision Ordinance:

Section 1. Section 602 of the city code is amended by adding the underlined and deleting the ~~stricken~~ language as follows:

602 Parking at Swimming Beach. In order to reduce noise, traffic hazards and litter, and because available parking at the swimming beach is very limited, parking at the swimming beach in the City of Minnetonka Beach shall be by “Permit” only. No person shall leave or park any motor vehicle or trailer as defined within Minnesota Statute, section 169.011 on ~~any lands, the streets, or public grounds~~ within the posted area adjacent to ~~any~~ the public swimming beach in the City of Minnetonka Beach without having attached to said motor vehicle or trailer a Permit issued as hereinafter provided for the current year which shall be affixed to the rear left side window in such a position as to be in clear view.

- (1) **Permits; Issuance.** Permits, as required by the term of Section 602, shall be issued by the City Clerk of the Village of Minnetonka Beach to any resident of the City and any person owning or holding real property situated within the corporate limits of the City. Upon request of any such person, a Permit shall be issued without charge. Parking for non-residents and non-real property owners wishing to use the swimming beach is available at other parks within the City.
- (2) **Permit; Revocation.** Permits issued as herein required, may be revoked by the City Council after hearing upon proof of a violation of any of the ordinances of the City of Minnetonka Beach or of the Statutes of Minnesota or upon proof that the holder of the permit has engaged in any activity which shall injure or endanger the safety, health or comfort of those persons using such swimming beach, public grounds, or streets adjacent thereto, or who shall fail to remove refuse, waste, or other deleterious substances from such swimming beach, public grounds, or streets adjacent thereto which he or she has deposited thereon during his or her use and enjoyment thereof.
- (3) **Signs.** The City Council shall direct that appropriate signs be posted or erected on the swimming beach, ~~public grounds,~~ or streets adjacent thereto which shall state that the permit established by the terms of Section 602 shall be required to permit parking within ~~any~~ such posted area.
